

General instructions for theoretical and practical examinations

These rules must be carefully read and understood by the candidates.

For practical examination

During the examination, the students will be required to wear:

- pants covering their whole legs;
- closed and flat shoes;
- a lab coat with long sleeves;
- if applicable, long hair tied back.

All these items will be brought by the candidate. In the event of default, the access to practical examination rooms will be forbidden

Safety glasses will be supplied and must be carried during the whole examination, even if the student wears prescription glasses. Contact lenses are prohibited. If students, especially those who wear prescription glasses, prefer their own safety glasses, they are allowed to bring them.

Any student who would fail to respect these rules will not be allowed to enter the lab.

The calculator will be the same as for the theoretical examination.

A pipet bulb will be used during the practical examination. For the purpose of equity in the preparation, the model that will be used is depicted on the adjacent figure and its description is available with this link:

For theoretical examination

No personal item will be allowed, including personal calculators.
